## Orchid of the Month: Pteroceras semiteretifolium

What a name! The long name might not match this small orchid, but good things come in small packages!

Members of the *Pteroceras* genus, about 19 in all, are native to Southeast Asia and India. This species, semiteretifolium, can be found growing on tree branches in Vietnam. Named for the shape of its leaves ("semi-terete" describes a smooth, circular cross-section and usually implies a long tapering form,) this small monopodial epiphyte typically blooms ±1.85cm (3/4 in.) white flowers, one per stalk.

A member of the *Vanda* family, this orchid is best grown in a hanging basket or mounted and usually requires moderate light and warm-to-hot temperatures. It prefers to be kept moist (but not wet) and does best when fertilized heavily.
