Orchid of the Month

This month's featured orchid is a plant most people are familiar with, but few seem to know is an orchid – *Vanilla*.

Vanilla's long thin stems grow like a vine to lengths of 100+ ft.! Like many orchids it is an epiphyte, growing harmlessly upon other plants or trees. Their roots grow down until they find something to attach to; be careful, one website says they'll even attach to your living room carpet if you're not careful! As you can imagine for an orchid growing in the tropics, they require bright, filtered light and warm temperatures, high humidity, and lots of space to grow.

Vanilla's blooms are short-lived and arise successively on short structures from between the leaves around the beginning of April. Each tubular-shaped flower lasts only 8 hours, is quite large, and gives off a slightly unpleasant smell (unless you are a bee). There can be up to 100 flowers on a single "vine" of *Vanilla*.

Commercially grown *Vanilla* plants are pollenated by hand, a very tricky procedure, which cause the plants to grow the much-prized vanilla bean. After ripening for some 8-9 months after pollination, the beans are harvested, yielding vanilla flavoring.
