#### Treasurer's Quarterly Report for April 2020

As expected, activity during the 3d quarter (Jan. 1- March 31, 2020) was light and shows a deficit. Total numbers for the fiscal year so far, however, look pretty good compared to last year. Maintaining a positive revenue balance will be critical for meeting the much higher show rental cost in November. And please remember to ask your employer if it matches donations, it can help a lot! 


